

Make your own FELT MISTLETOE

- 1. Cut 4-5 leaf shapes out of green colored felt. Using multiple colors of green is ideal for a more natural, varied look.
- 2. Stack your leaf shapes together making sure to turn some of them over as you stack. This varies the look of the leaves.
- 3. Make a loop of yarn, twine, or string long enough for the mistletoe to hang from.
- 4. Lay this looped string between the stems of some of the leaf layers you've stacked.
- 5. Wrap the top stems and loop several times to hold all the layers together. Tie knot to secure ends.
- 6. Lastly, glue white or red pom poms of varying sizes to the leaves for a berry effect.
- 7. Hang and enjoy!
